The conditions of students' acceptance into the university:

- 1. The student must be a Saudi national or a Saudi mother.
- 2. Obtaining a high school certificate (scientific) or equivalent from inside or outside the Kingdom.
- 3. The student must pass the aptitude and achievement tests for scientific and literary students issued by the National Centre for Measurement.
- 4. The university only accepts students who have withdrawn from any other educational entity if the withdrawal has passed three or more months before the start of admission. Moreover, the university only accepts students who have withdrawn from the university after four semesters.
- 5. No more than five years have passed since the high school certificate. Only accepts certificates from 1435-1436 AH and beyond.
- 6. The student must be free to study.
- 7. The student must not be dismissed from the university or any other university for disciplinary dismissal.
- 8. Bank accounts are preferred.

Admission conditions for scholarship students are the following:

- 1. Applicants applying for the local scholarship must meet the requirements applicable to Saudis in higher education institutions.
- 2. The applicant must be a legal resident in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia before the start of the academic year.
- 3. Applicant's age average must be between 17-25 for undergraduate studies. The applicant must not be older than (30) years for the master's program and (35) years for

the doctoral program. The University Council may grant a waiver of these requirements.

- 4. The applicant must have a high school certificate (scientific) or equivalent from the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia or abroad.
- 5. The applicant's secondary certificate should be issued by a public school or an equivalent school recognized by the University.
- 6. Applicants who graduated from high school over five years ago are not eligible to apply.
- 7. The applicant should have good conduct.
- 8. The applicant should be medically fit.
- 9. The applicant should comply with the University regulations.
- 10. S/he should pass any test or personal interview conducted by the University.
- 11. The student should commit to full-time study rather than be employed.
- 12. The applicant must have a certificate of General Aptitude Test (GAT) and Scholastic Achievement Admission Test (SAAT) if his/her secondary certificate has been earned from a Saudi school.
- 13. A guardian with valid residency cards should accompany female students.
- 14. All certificates and supporting documents from outside the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia should be certified by authorized institutions.
- 15. Students of internal and external scholarships can apply for any program offered by the University, except for medical specialties.
- 16. The applicant should have received an offer of admission from someone other than another educational institution in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.
- 17. The applicant should meet all other requirements set by the University council and announced during the application timeframe.
- 18. All required documents should be attached to the application.

The conditions for the admission of new students to the faculty are the following:

- 1. The Required number of seats for admission to the college.
- 2. To obtain a high calculated score as follows: Score = (0.5 * General Secondary Ratio) + (0.25 * Achievement Test Score) + (0.25 * Capacity Test Result)

The conditions for the admission of new students to the Computer Science program:

- 1. The student must pass the Introduction to Computer Science course 1105101 with success on the first attempt, with grades of at least 70% (C).
- 2. The student's grade point average (GPA) should be at least 2.5 out of 5 in general preparation courses.
- 3. Priority is given to students with the highest GPA, provided that the number of those accepted is at most the department's capacity.
- 4. The student should complete at least twenty-one credits of general preparation courses or their equivalent from available preparation courses if s/he is transferring from another university or college.
- 5. The admission committee is free to exclude any of the above conditions after referring the department council and in the public interest. Provided that the program determines the department's absorptive capacity in all sections before the start of the allocation periods and it is sent to the College Agency for Academic Affairs.
